

# Gospel on a Page

## God's creation and redemption of man

### *Features*

- Needs only two sheets of paper.
- Symbolic pictures are added, changed and moved.
- Creation to the return of Jesus is depicted on a single page.
- The *Gospel on a Page* can be used in any language. There are no written words on the picture sheet.

### *Printing guideline*

- Use white or yellow construction paper (card).
- For best results, laminate the main sheet.

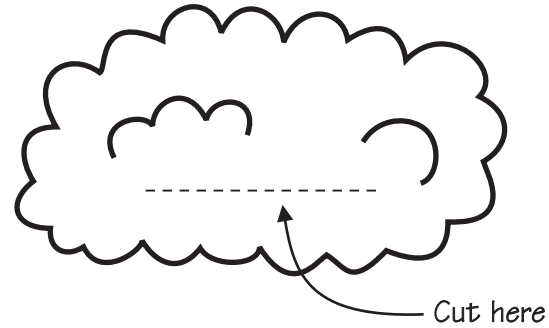
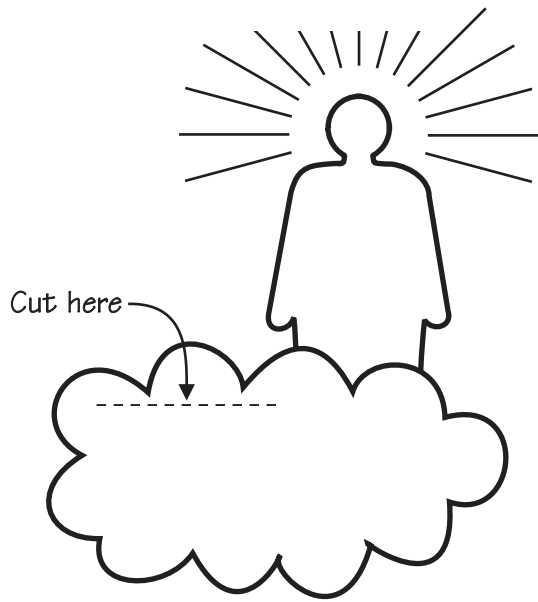
### *Using the page*

- It is best to have a helper holding the picture sheet while moving the pieces through the steps.
- Have the cut-outs ready but not obviously visible.
- Explain the Gospel simply and in your own words.
- Allow the child/ren to ask questions by pointing to something that may not be clear. Let the child repeat the story using the pieces.

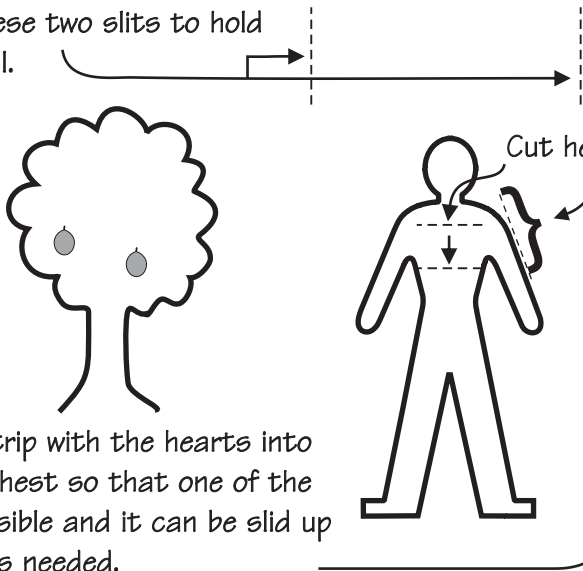


# Storyboard cutting instructions

The main page on which the cut-outs are placed looks like this. On the main page, cut slits where indicated so that the cut-outs can be fitted into them. Complete slit lines are not printed on the main page so use this as a guide.

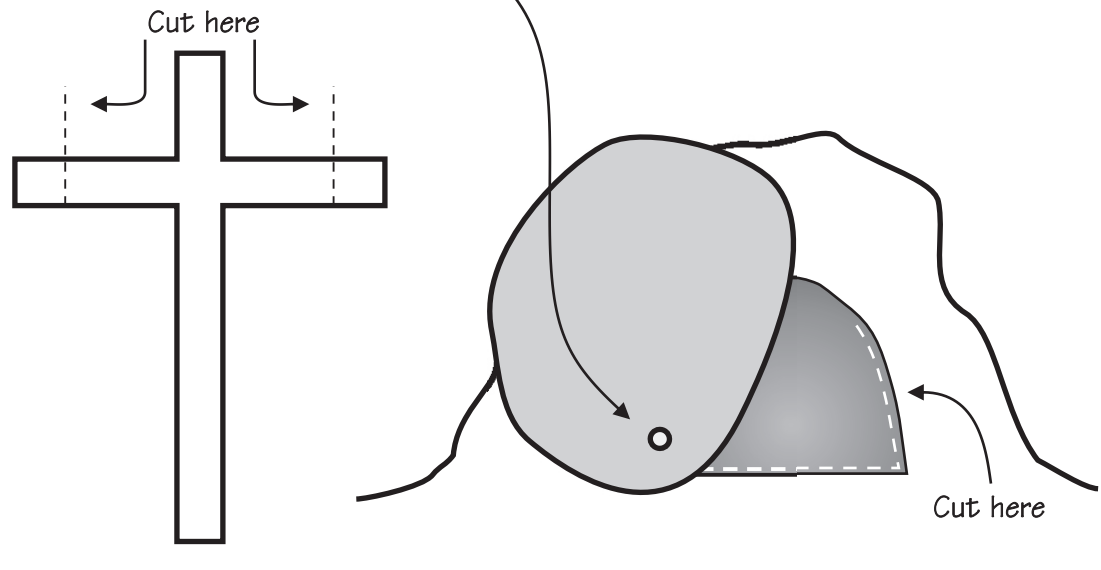


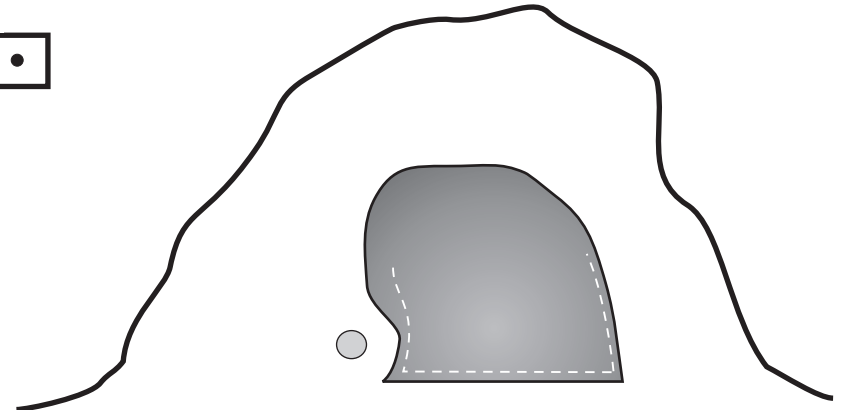
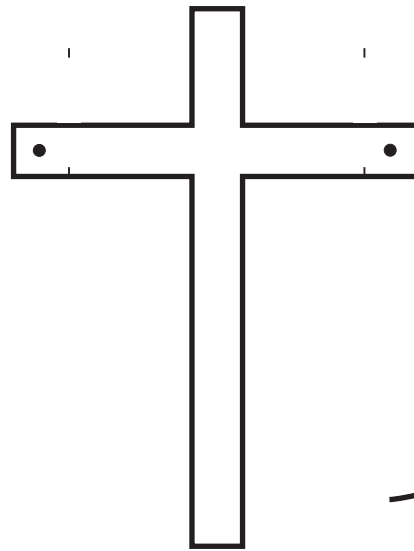
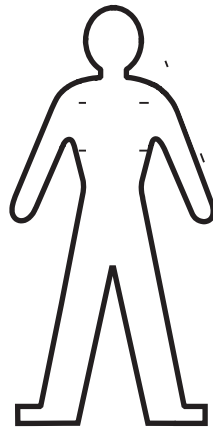
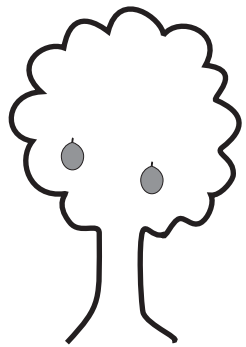
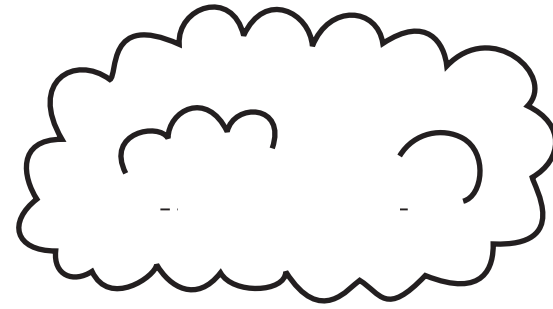
Tuck the dark sin barrier in between these two slits to hold it horizontal.



Tuck this strip with the hearts into the man's chest so that one of the hearts is visible and it can be slid up and down as needed.

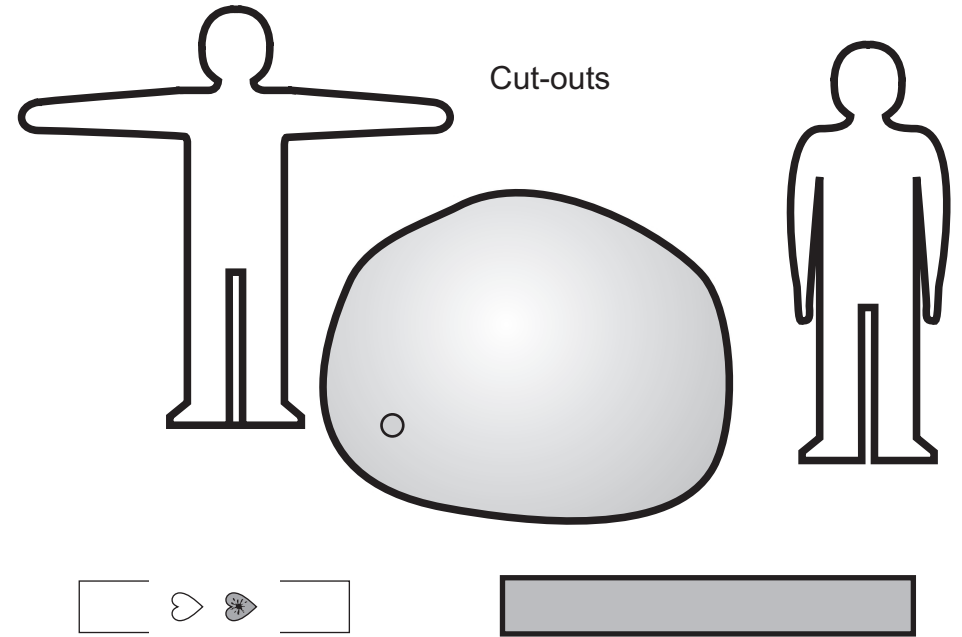
Fasten the stone to the cave entrance with a split pin.





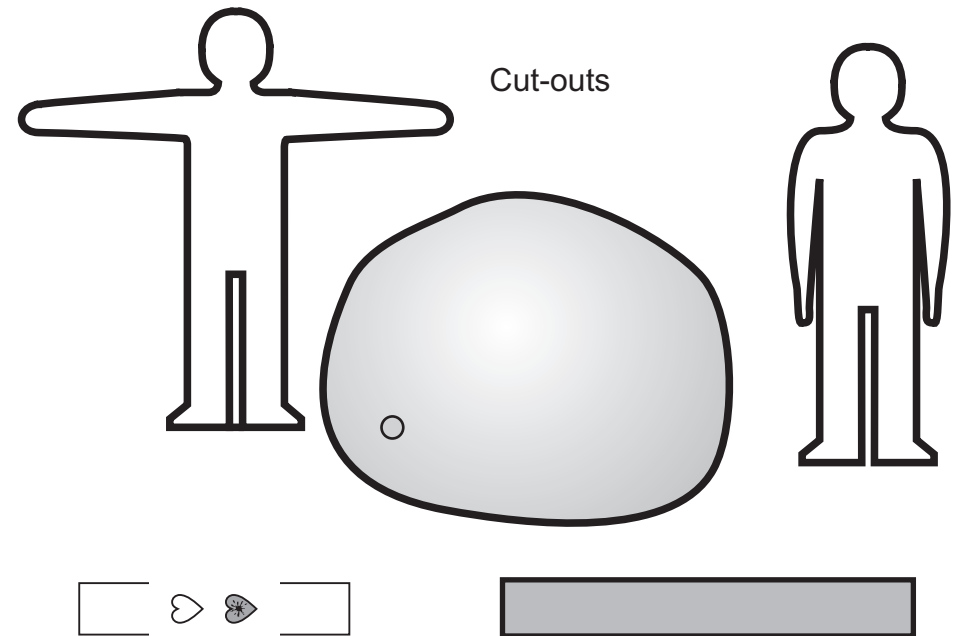

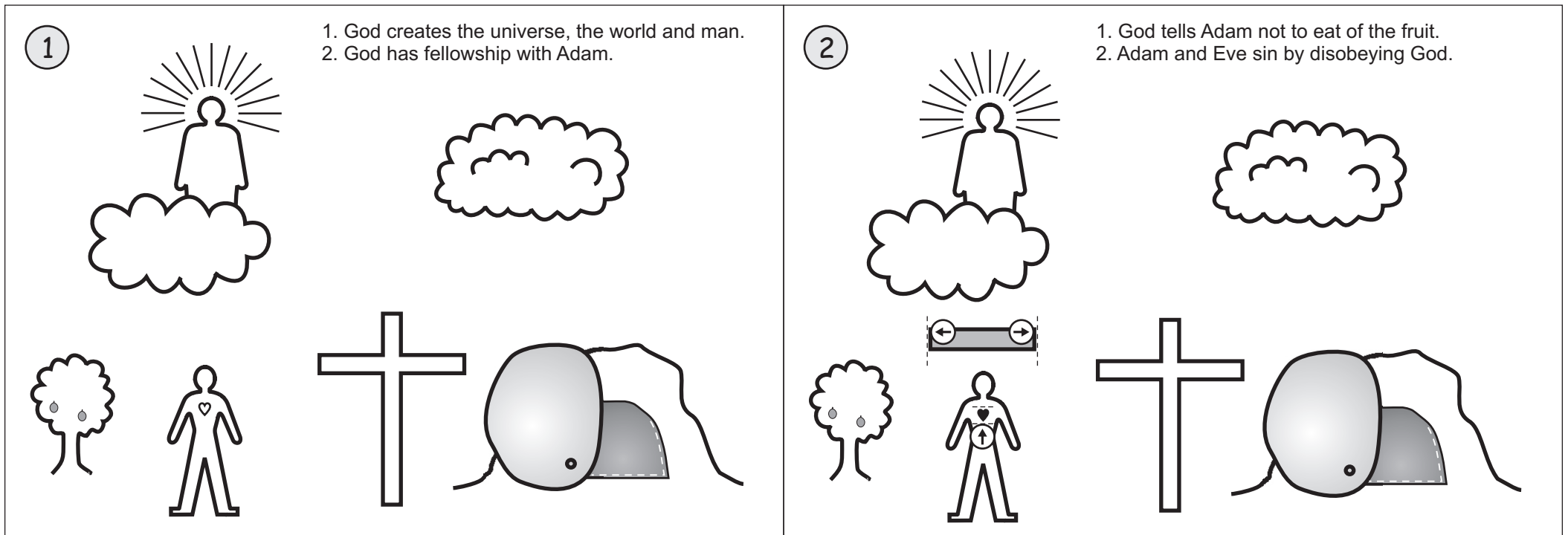

## Step-by-step activity on the sheet

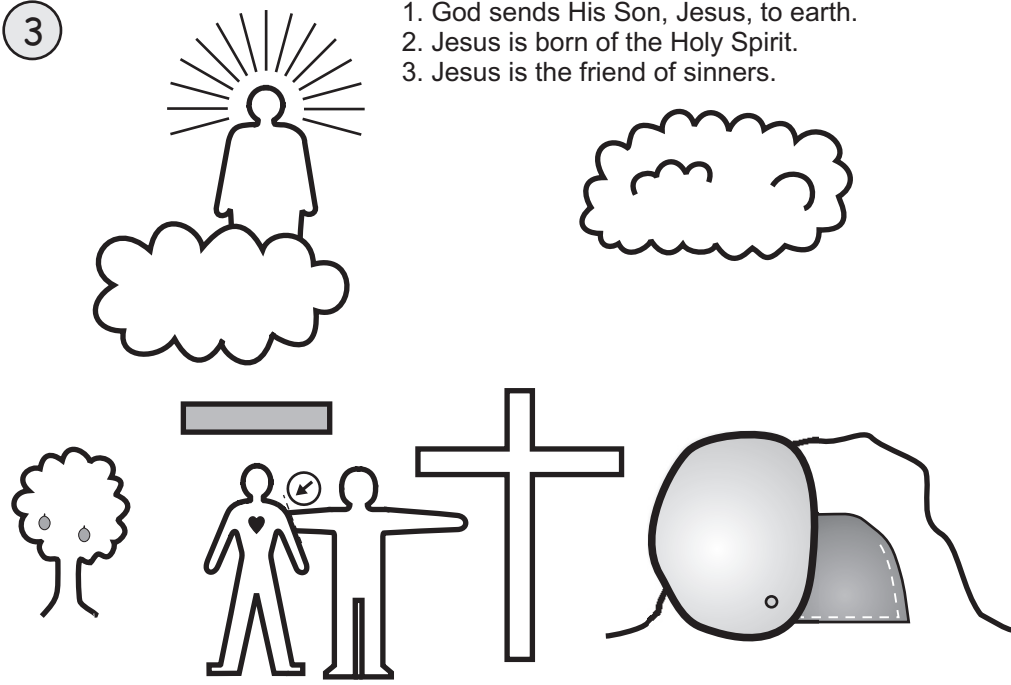
- ① Explain that God created everything that exists. *He created Adam and Eve perfect but not all-powerful. Gen.1:26-27*
- ② *God told Adam not to eat of the fruit of the tree in the middle of the garden. Point to the tree. But Adam and Eve disobeyed God and ate the fruit, and so sin entered the world. Place the sin barrier between God and man. Change the heart of the man to a dark heart. Gen. 2:17, Isa. 59:2*
- ③ *God sent Jesus to earth. Place Jesus next to the man, with His arm around him to demonstrate His love and care. John 3:16*
- ④ *Men arrested Jesus and had Him crucified. Place Jesus on the cross. Take the sin barrier and place it on Jesus. Now we can ask God to take away our sin and give us a clean heart. Change the man's heart to the clean heart. John 19:17-18, Isa. 53:6, 1 John 1:9*

- ⑤ *Jesus was placed in a tomb. Put Jesus in the tomb together with the sin barrier. Use the picture of Jesus with His arms at His side. Explain how He was wrapped in linen. Mark 15:46, 1 Pet. 3:18*
- ⑥ *The tomb was sealed. Move the large stone across the entrance. Matt. 27:59-60*
- ⑦ *On the third day, Jesus rose from the dead. Move the stone to the side and show Jesus arising. Matt. 28:2*
- ⑧ *After Jesus had shown Himself to His disciples and others, He ascended to Heaven. Show Jesus disappearing into the clouds. John 20:20, Acts 1:9*
- ⑨ *Jesus is seated at the right hand of God. Show Jesus next to God. (With the arms placed in front of the cloud, the figure will not slide out). Mark 16:19*
- ⑩ *Jesus is coming back in the clouds. Show Jesus appearing in the same way He left earth. 1 Thess. 4:17*



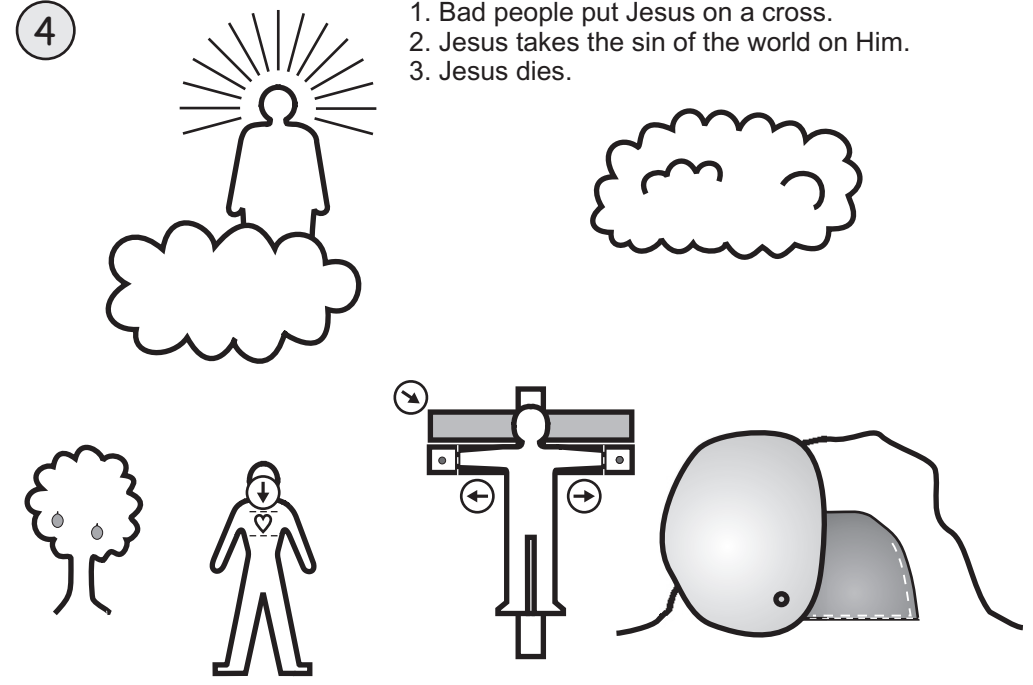

3. Jesus is the friend of sinners.



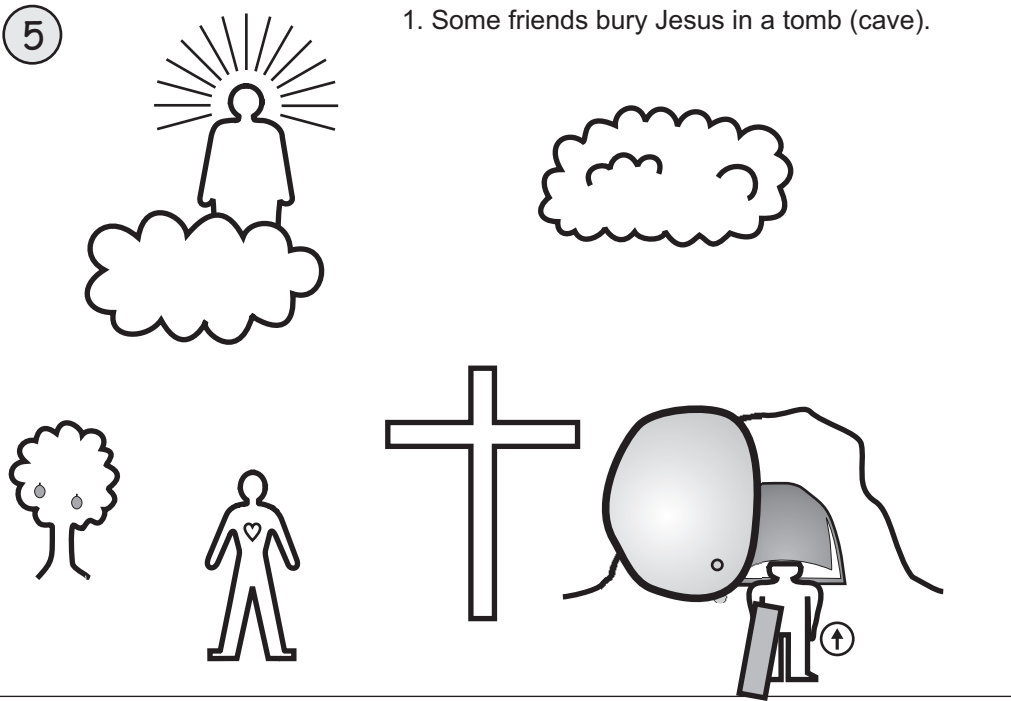

3. Jesus dies.



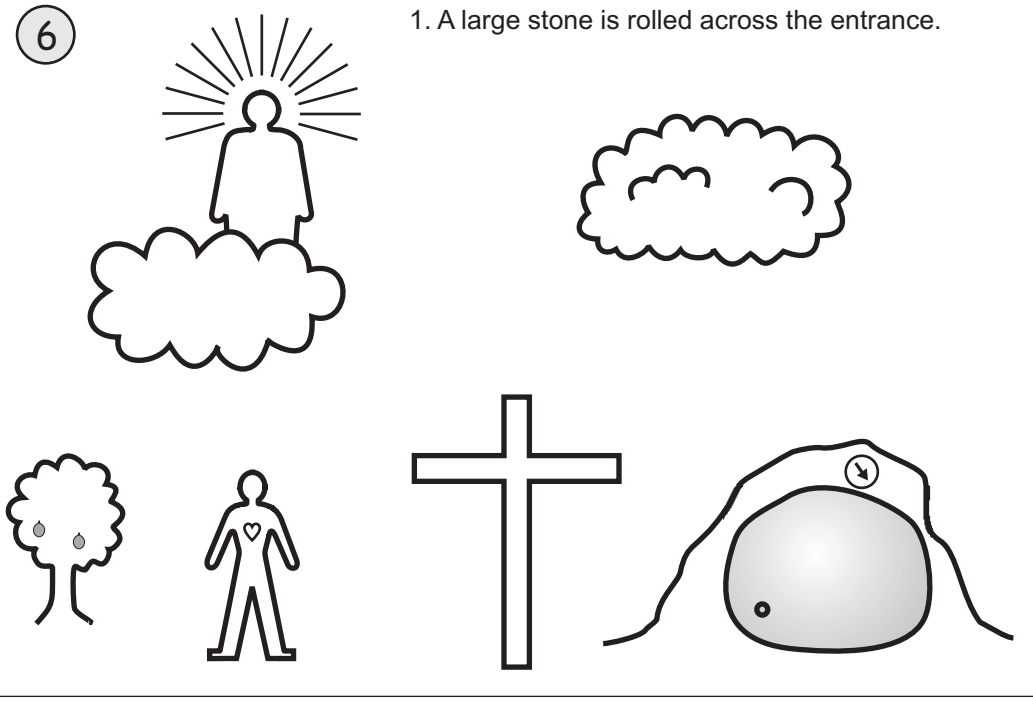

1. Some friends bury Jesus in a tomb (cave).



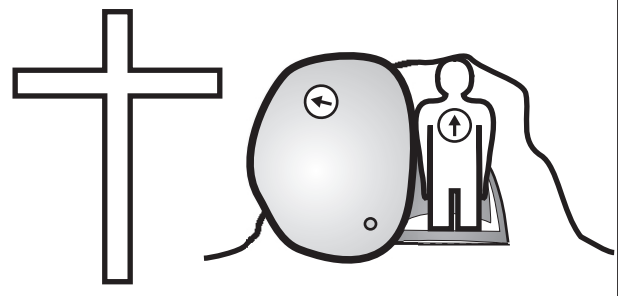
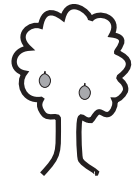

1. A large stone is rolled across the entrance.



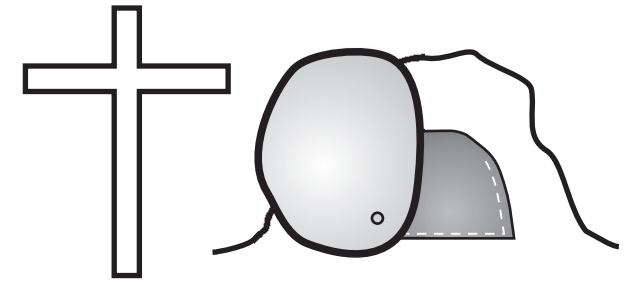
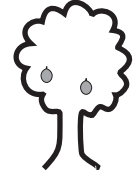

3. He shows Himself to His friends.



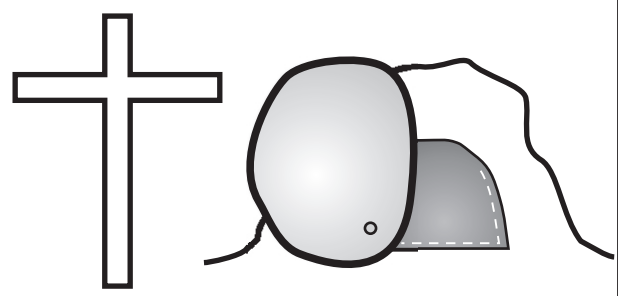
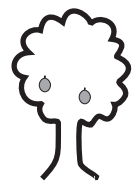
